

**FACTS****WHAT DOES STREETBEAT LLC DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?**

<b>Why?</b>	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
<b>What?</b>	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the products or services you have with us. This information can include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Social Security number and date of birth</li> <li>▪ Account balances and transaction history</li> <li>▪ Information about you and your finances</li> </ul> When you are <i>no longer</i> our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.
<b>How?</b>	All financial companies need to share clients' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their clients' personal information; the reasons StreetBeat chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

<b>Who is providing this notice?</b>	StreetBeat LLC is providing this notice on behalf of itself and its affiliates. See the list of affiliates below.
What we do	
<b>How does StreetBeat protect my personal information?</b>	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
<b>How does StreetBeat collect my personal information?</b>	We collect your personal information, for example, when you: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ open an account or deposit money</li> <li>▪ apply for financing or provide account information</li> <li>▪ pay your bills</li> </ul> We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.
<b>Why can't I limit all sharing?</b>	Federal law gives you the right to limit only: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes – information about your creditworthiness</li> <li>▪ affiliates from using your information to market to you</li> <li>▪ sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you</li> </ul> State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. [See below for more on your rights under state law.]
<b>What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?</b>	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account.
Definitions	
<b>Affiliates</b>	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <i>StreetBeat's affiliates include its parent company, Nowcasting.ai, Inc., and the subsidiaries of its parent company: StreetBeat Financial LLC.</i></li> </ul>
<b>Nonaffiliates</b>	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <i>StreetBeat does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.</i></li> </ul>
<b>Joint marketing</b>	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <i>StreetBeat's joint marketing partners can include financial service companies.</i></li> </ul>
Other important information	
<p>We share your personal information with nonaffiliates to provide services to you. For example, we share information with Alpaca Securities, LLC, the third-party broker on your account, to execute your security transactions. We also share information with Plaid, Inc., the third-party vendor that provides connections between your financial institutions. We require strict confidentiality in our agreements with nonaffiliates.</p> <p><b>California Residents.</b> We will not share information we collect about you with non-affiliated third parties, except as permitted by law, such as to process your transactions or to maintain your account. We also send California residents a California notice for additional choices.</p> <p><b>Vermont Residents.</b> We will not share information we collect about you with non-affiliated third parties, except as permitted by law, such as to process your transactions or maintain your account. We may share your information with our affiliates, so they may market to you. However, we will not share information about your creditworthiness with affiliates.
